issued to low-income families

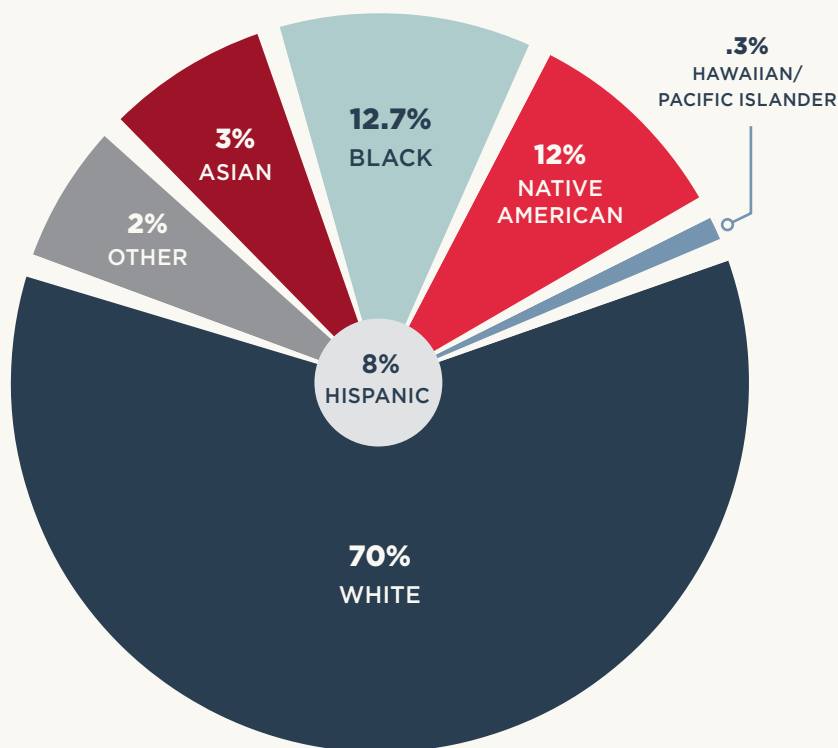
